



Rising singer-songwriter **Avery Lynch** reveals her new single, "[Rain](#)," out today via RECORDS. Following her '[As Written, Vol. 2](#)

' project, a collection of reimagined fan-favorites and new tracks presented in their most stripped-back form, Avery returns with a track that is both achingly personal and powerfully cinematic.

"Rain" opens with delicate strings and gentle piano, a hauntingly beautiful backdrop that allows Avery's captivating vocals to shine. As the track swells with sweeping, atmospheric production, it pulls listeners deeper into its emotive current. The lyrics feel as if they've been ripped straight from the pages of her diary—each word heavy with heartache and longing.

"I wrote 'Rain' about a time when my boyfriend and I were broken up and I was asked on a date by someone else," Avery explains. "It recounts everything I was experiencing—where I was, what I felt, and what I wanted. It means a lot to me and it's so cool to see how much it means to others, too."

Born and raised in Pennsylvania, Avery Lynch began her musical journey at the age of 7, composing piano pieces before evolving into songwriting just a year later. Her sound, rooted in lush piano arrangements and soft, romantic vocals, has remained a hallmark of her artistry. She starts each of her songs alone with her piano before bringing the demos to her close-knit team who help her bring the music to life.

Often described as a "happy girl filled with sad songs," Avery's music is anchored in heartfelt storytelling inspired by her life experiences, the world around her, and the media she consumes. Since making her debut in 2020, she's cultivated a loyal fanbase, even creating songs inspired by her followers' comments and thoughts. With over 100 million streams to date and a freshly inked deal with **RECORDS**, Avery Lynch is an artist destined for stardom.
